Parental Consent, Authorization for Treatment, and Check-Out Procedure Authorization

Parental Consent & Property Damage Contract

I wish to enroll my child in the Rob Beam Volleyball Camps at Oakland University. I release the State of Michigan, Oakland University, and Rob Beam Volleyball Camps LLC, and any and all persons associated with Rob Beam Volleyball Camps LLC from any and all liability for any injury, medical or dental, sustained by my child. I also indemnify the same parties from any responsibility for liability, loss, or damage done to any facility or equipment by the participant as a result of negligent or willful act done by my child or ward. I accept responsibility for paying damage charges before my child leaves camp. Finally, I certify that I have medical insurance for my child.

Authorization for Treatment

I hereby give my permission to the physician selected by the camp sponsors to order X-rays, lab tests, and provide treatment for my child as named above while attending Rob Beam Volleyball Camps. In the event I cannot be reached for an emergency, I hereby give permission to the physician selected by the camp sponsors to secure and administer such treatment(s) as may be necessary, including hospitalization, for my child as named above and while attending the camp named above. A photo copy is as valid as the original.

Check-Out Procedure and Authorization Statement

In order to make our camps as safe as possible we have instituted a "Check-Out Procedure" that we will follow at the conclusion of each camp day. We will consider both Emergency Contacts as stated on our registration form as "Authorized for Check-Out". Also, we will permit up to three additional adults (defined as 18 and older) or siblings, that are listed as "Authorized for Check-Out" in the fields below.

At the conclusion of each of our individual camps we will have alphabetical lists by last name at tables in the hallway of the second floor of the Athletics Center or in the O'rena. One person that is "Authorized for Check-Out" must provide a signature, date, and a phone number for contact on the form prior to taking a camper.

At the conclusion of each day of team camp, each court coach or high school coach will have a list in the O'rena of their team members. One person that is "Authorized for Check-Out" must provide a signature, date, and a phone number for contact on the form prior to taking a camper.

We will also take attendance at the beginning of each camp session. If your camper is not going to be present or will be late, please call us at 248-370-4057 to notify us. If she is not present at attendance we will call those listed as Emergency Contacts at the earliest possible time.
